Purpose

The State of Vermont has received an extension to the Money Follows the Person (MFP) grant for calendar year 2020. The additional funds will be available to approximately forty-four (44) Choices for Care (CFC) participants. Anyone that meets the MFP eligibility requirements and transitioned during 2020 from a nursing facility to a qualified community-based residence will be eligible for this CFC program.

Eligibility for MFP Grant Extension Participation

- Vermont resident
- Meet requirements for 90 consecutive days in a qualified nursing facility
- Receiving Vermont Long-Term Care Medicaid and on Choices for Care
- Transition to an MFP qualified community setting
- Must have transitioned anytime during CY20 (01/01/2020 to 12/31/2020)

Transition Funds and Services

There will be up to \$2,500 available to each qualifying MFP participant to be used to eliminate barriers and to sustain their successful transition to a qualified home-based setting. In addition to these funds, transition coordinators will be made available for discharge planning support and post-transition follow-up assistance.
